






### **Covid Vaccines - Arriving from another country**

## To be protected from Covid: the vaccines in France



In France, the vaccine is recommended from 5 years old. It is not obligatory.

To be well-protected, normally you need 2 doses and a booster injection.

Certain foreign vaccinations are recognised in France.

Others need 1 or 2 extra doses. A booster will be necessary in most cases after several months.

## For a primo-vaccination to be recognised in France:

Covaxin, Sinopharm, Sinovac	Complete 💆	Have 1 vaccine dose
	Incomplete [	Have 2 vaccine doses
Sputnik and others	Complete 💆	Have 2 vaccine doses interval of between 21 and 49 days
	Incomplete [	Have 2 vaccine doses interval of between 21 and 49 days

<sup>\*</sup> Completed primo-vaccination: normally 2 doses or 1 dose if you have already had Covid

To protect vulnerable people

## The vaccine or a negative test is obligatory for:

- Certain healthcare jobs (up-to-date Covid vaccination).
- To go into a hospital (up-to-date Covid vaccination or negative Covid test).



## How to get vaccinated?

The vaccine is free. You can be vaccinated without a social security card or state medical aid (Aide médicale d'Etat AME).

A postal address, even a temporary one, may be requested.

The vaccination is done in a vaccination center, in a chemist, by a health professional or with some non-statutory organisations.
